

How to contact Coaches

- 1. Study the program you are about to contact. Visit the website and get a feeling for their team and past seasons.**
- 2. Ask your current club coaches to fill in their contact info.**
- 3. Mention EuroRecruiting and your profile. Include a backlink.**
- 4. Write the letter and don't forget following aspects**
 - Tell the particular coach who you are
 - Don't hide your strengths, but remain realistic, don't exaggerate
 - Include statistics to underline your talent
 - Inform the coach about the subject you intend to study
 - It is always good to mention the strengths of your character, your work ethic, etc. If possible, add extracurricular activities.
 - End your letter with letting the coach know to send him a questionnaire, if he is interested in the program and that you'd be very delighted to get in contact with him.
- 5. Reread the letter and double check everything.**
- 6. Formal aspects:**

Center your name, address and telephone number across the top of the second page. Skipping down an inch or two, write the names, full titles and all methods of contact (school phone, cellphone, email) for your coach references. Separated by another blank space, list the online recruiting website you are enrolled in, their complete web addresses, and all information necessary for the coach to locate you in that particular database.
